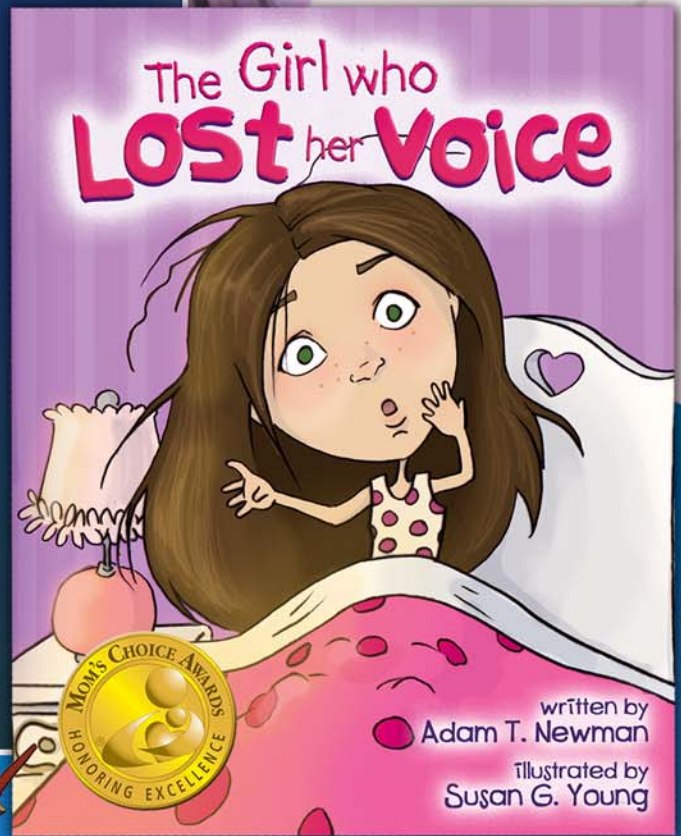


About The Show

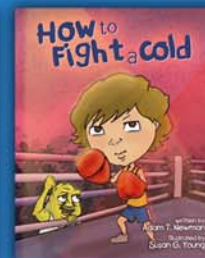
SUGGESTED AUDIENCE: Grades K – 3
